
Feb. 3rd "Soup"er Bowl Sunday

What is D.Now?

Discipleship Now (D.Now) is a weekend retreat format for students grades 6-12 that emphasizes discipleship and growth in a student's faith and includes both large and small group sessions.

Where is D.Now?

There are group sessions at the church as well as individual sessions led by adults at the host homes. Students stay at local host homes where they share in Bible Study, individual devotion time, and have fun in small group settings.

Sample Schedule

Friday ~ 6pm: Gather at the church for food, games, group building, Bible study and worship. 9pm: Depart for host homes, Small Group Sessions
